Description	<p>The College Level Examination Program (CLEP), a nationally recognized competency testing opportunity, was developed to enable individuals to earn college credit by examination.</p> <p>Credit is awarded to students who achieve acceptable scores on the general CLEP battery and/or specific CLEP subject matter examinations. The general battery includes examinations in English, humanities, mathematics, and natural sciences/history. A list of subject examinations is offered on reverse of this page.</p>
QCC Policy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A maximum of 32 credits is allowed if all general examinations are passed▪ Credit is awarded for scores at or above the 50th percentile on the general exams, and in individual exams that relate to specific courses that are available at the college▪ Cannot be used to replace F, I, or I/R grade
Student Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Certain restrictions apply to CRJ students, due to Board of Higher Education mandate
Information for Advisors	<p>A student is a good candidate for CLEP if s/he has acquired substantial knowledge in general education subjects, such as english, math, history, or psychology.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ For a comprehensive listing of CLEP subject areas, consult the College Board web site (See "For more information" below)▪ Advise student to discuss CLEP examination plan with registrar prior to test registration to confirm that it will satisfy program requirements or electives▪ Specific questions and information about CLEP are available through the Registrar's Office▪ Search CLEP test centers near you at https://clep.collegeboard.org/test-center-search
