#### What is a waitlisted program?

✓ A waitlisted program is a program that has more accepted students then spaces available because it is a high demand program.

#### Why are there waitlisted programs?

✓ The number of spaces available is limited by the number of clinicals available to students. The amount of clinical spaces is determined by the clinical site.

## What steps do I need to take to be placed on the program's waitlist?

- ✓ Complete the program admissions requirements.
- ✓ Please review the program admissions requirements.
- ✓ Print out the program admissions requirements and use it as a checklist and mark date of completion for each program admissions requirement to track your progress.
- ✓ Upon completion of the program admissions requirements, your application will be reviewed by an evaluator to determine satisfactory completion of the program admissions requirements.

- ✓ You can only be on a waitlist for one waitlisted program.
- ✓ If you meet the program admissions requirements, you will be mailed an acceptance letter with a start term date i.e., FALL 2021. If you are denied acceptance to the program a letter will mailed to you telling you why.

## How can I move up on the waitlist?

✓ If an earlier space becomes available, you will be notified by the admissions office.



#### - HEALTH INFORMATION SESSIONS -

#### What is a Health Info session?

- ✓ The Health Info session includes career and academic program information, admission program requirements, waitlists, and completion of the healthcare program intent form.
- ✓ Attending a Health Info session is an admission program requirement for many of the QCC healthcare programs. Check the program admissions requirements for your intended program.

#### How do I register for a Health Info session?

#### What do I need to bring to the Health Info Session?

- ✓ Your student id#,
- ✓ Arrive 15 minutes early
- ✓ If you are more than 15 minutes late you will need to reschedule



#### - TEAS Test -

#### What is the TEAS?

✓ The TEAS is the Test for Essential Academic skills and is a program admissions requirement for many of the QCC Healthcare programs. The TEAS tests your skill level for English, Science, Math and Writing.

#### When should I take the TEAS?

✓ You are encouraged to take the TEAS when you feel you are prepared for all four subject areas. If you need to take a science or math course to qualify for admission to a healthcare program, then it is recommended that you complete the course before taking the TEAS.

#### How many times can I take the TEAS?

- ✓ You are only allowed to take the TEAS tree times within three years of applying to the program.
- ✓ Prior TEAS scores are accepted if they were taken within 5 years of application completion.
