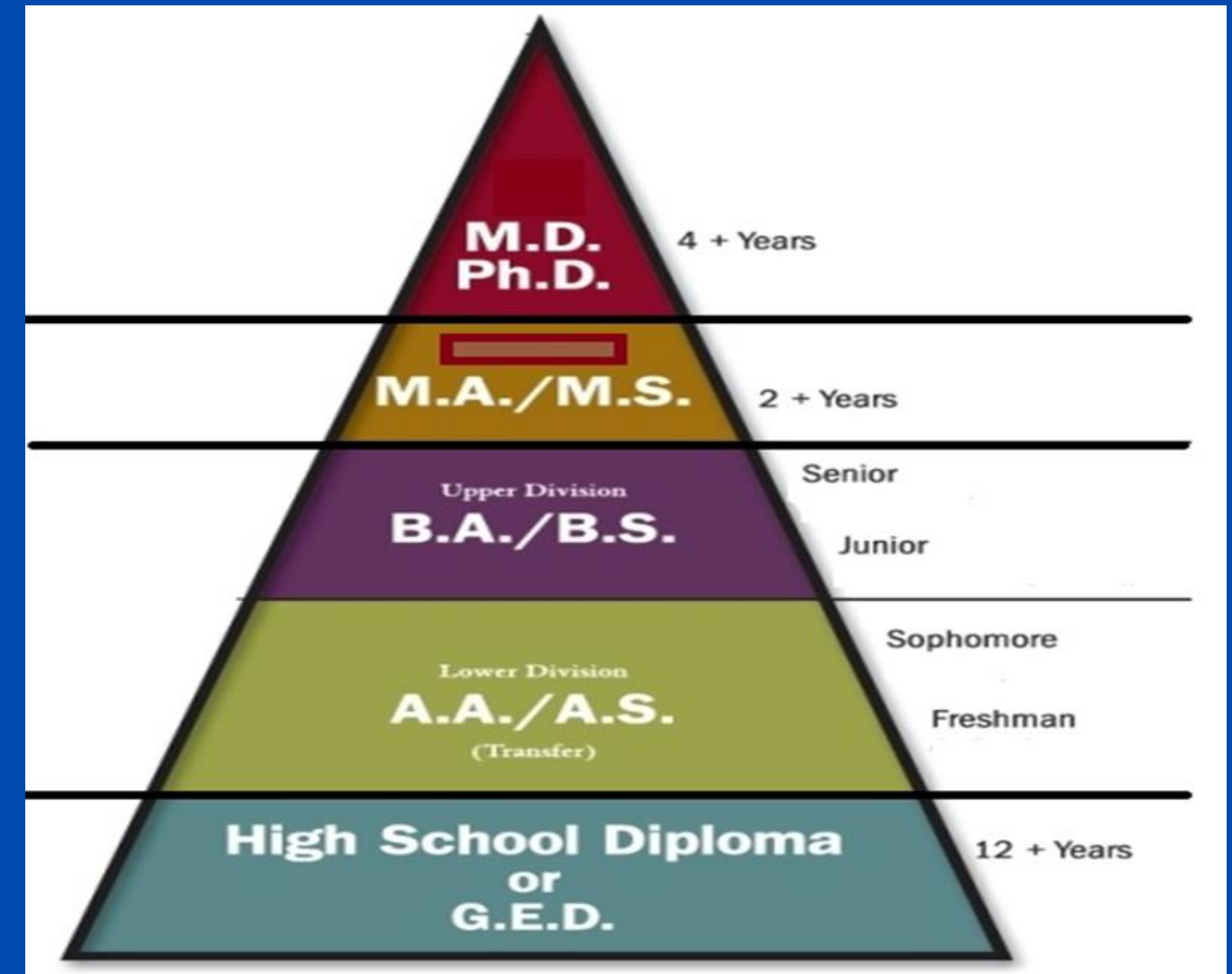
# DEGREE BREAKDOWN

## Associate Degree:

- 60-65 credits
- 24-33:General Education
- 24-30: Major
- 3-14: Elective

## Bachelor's Degree:

- 120+ credits
- 45-60: General Education
- 36-60: Major
- 12-24: Electives

## RESEARCH BACHELORS PROGRAMS

Start making decisions. Will you attend full time or part time? Online or in person? Will you live on campus or commute? What will you study? What are your long-term career goals? What type of extracurricular activities will you do?

## TRANSFER AGREEMENTS

Research Mass Transfer and Private Transfer agreements available at QCC in your program of study.

## NARROW DOWN YOUR OPTIONS

Research each college's admission requirements, scholarships available, go on tours, attend transfer events, and begin to narrow down your search to 2-5 schools.

## FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Determine which institution provides the best overall value through financial aid, scholarship opportunities and investment in your future.

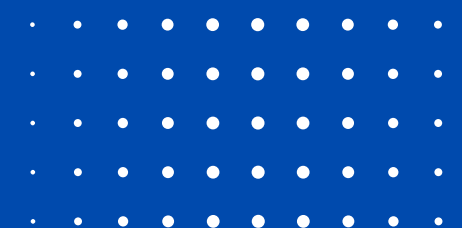

- ✓ Complete your associate degree within 2.5 years
- ✓ Transfer to a Massachusetts State Universities or UMass campus
- ✓ Complete your bachelor's degree within 2 more years
- ✓ Maintain full-time continuous enrollment and a cumulative 3.00 GPA

## Commonwealth Commitment Benefits:

- ✓ Freeze on all tuition & mandatory fees at the level in place during the semester the student starts the Commonwealth Commitment Pathway
- ✓ Valid until bachelor's degree completion providing the student stays in compliance with continuous enrollment and GPA requirements
- ✓ A 10% rebate of tuition & mandatory fees  
Payable at the end of every successfully completed semester
- ✓ Additional MassTransfer Tuition Credit on bachelor's program entry
- ✓ Guaranteed admission  
Space permitting in the major and college
- ✓ Guaranteed transfer of credits
- ✓ No application fee or essay
